

## Practical 9 – Web Map/Story Map Practice

Practical 9 requires you to create either an original Web Map **OR** Story Map. Choose either A or B below.

**A. Please build a Web Map that meets the following requirements:**

- 1. Engaging Title** (1 mark)
- 2. Layers of Data** (2 marks)
  - a. Include at least two layers of data from any source
- 3. Symbolize Data** (2 marks)
  - a. Use ArcGIS Online tools to symbolize the data
- 4. Bookmark** (1 mark)
  - a. Include at least one spatial bookmark
- 5. Hyperlink** (1 mark)
  - a. Include at least one hyperlink
- 6. Question(s) for Learners** (3 marks)
  - a. Include at least three popup menus containing geographic questions for the learners to answer using the web map.

**B. Please build a Story Map that meets with following requirements:**

- 1. Engaging Introductory Slide** (2 marks)
  - a. Title, Sub-title, Background Picture, Your Name
- 2. Relevant Text** (2 marks)
  - a. Divide your text into sentences and short paragraphs
  - b. Include at least one properly formatted hyperlink
  - c. No more than 1000 words total
- 3. At Least One Original Webmap** (2 marks)
  - a. Make your webmap interactive with pop-ups and hyperlinks
- 4. At least 4 multi-media items** (2 marks)
  - a. Pictures, videos, graphics
  - b. Include a caption with properly formatted hyperlinked citation for all media
- 5. “Teacher Notes Section”** (2 marks)
  - a. Guiding Questions for Learners
  - b. CAPS Links (description of how the Story Map relates to CAPS objectives)
  - c. References List (website links)
